

WhatsApp Messenger instructions

Audiences attending *The Believers Are But Brothers* are asked to join a WhatsApp group chat as part of the performance. This is optional but will enhance your experience as up to a third of the performance takes place in this WhatsApp group chat.

WhatsApp Messenger is an instant messaging service. The application allows the sending of text messages and voice calls, as well as video calls, images and other media, documents, and user location. The group chat feature allows you to send the same message to multiple contacts at the same time, and have conversation with a group of people. All data is end-to-end encrypted.

In preparation for the show please download WhatsApp messenger from the app store to your smart phone.

How to install WhatsApp

Go to your app store on your phone, search for WhatsApp and download:

1. Open WhatsApp and continue to the next screen by agreeing to the Terms of Service.
2. Verify your phone number.
3. If a backup of your chat history was found and you would like to restore it, choose Restore.
4. Lastly, type in your name if you would like to be named in the group or you can leave it as your number for anonymity.
5. You will be added to the 'Believers' group for the duration of the performance.

If you already have WhatsApp

If you want to remain anonymous, please change your name within WhatsApp. After the show, you can revert back to using your name. Please note that your number will be visible within the group chat while in use but will be deleted as soon as the show ends.

Post show

After each show, the WhatsApp group will be cleared and your phone number will be deleted. Your number will not be stored by the company or passed on to any third party groups.
